Please note: An amendment to the constitution regarding the Play Reading Committee will be proposed at the meeting:

Present By-Law: 14.08 – c.

Five (5) persons to serve as a Play Reading Committee. The committee shall select a Chairperson from among its members. The committee shall recommend the show bill for the upcoming season, including play reading and director selection to the Executive Committee, for final approval.

Replacement By-Law Recommendation

Three (3) persons to serve as a Play Reading Committee, including one (1) member of the Executive Committee, who shall act as Chair of the Play Reading Committee. This committee shall recommend the show bill for the upcoming season to the Executive Committee, including the order of the plays, proposed dates, and proposed directors, if possible. The Executive Committee shall implement these recommendations if possible, but shall not be bound by the recommendations and shall make the final determinations regarding the season. The Play Reading Committee shall make their recommendations by the 15th day of January prior to the first production of the season being recommended.
